This report contains the 2019 intended wheat seedings for the Southern Plains region resulting from data collected during the December 2018 Agriculture Survey. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the December Agriculture Survey, your responses are the foundation of these estimates for the Southern Plains.

Oklahoma seedings for the 2019 wheat crop are forecast at 4.20 million acres, down 5 percent from last year. Canola seedings are forecast at 30.0 thousand, down 57 percent from last year.

Texas seedings for the 2019 wheat crop are forecast at 4.50 million acres, unchanged from last year.

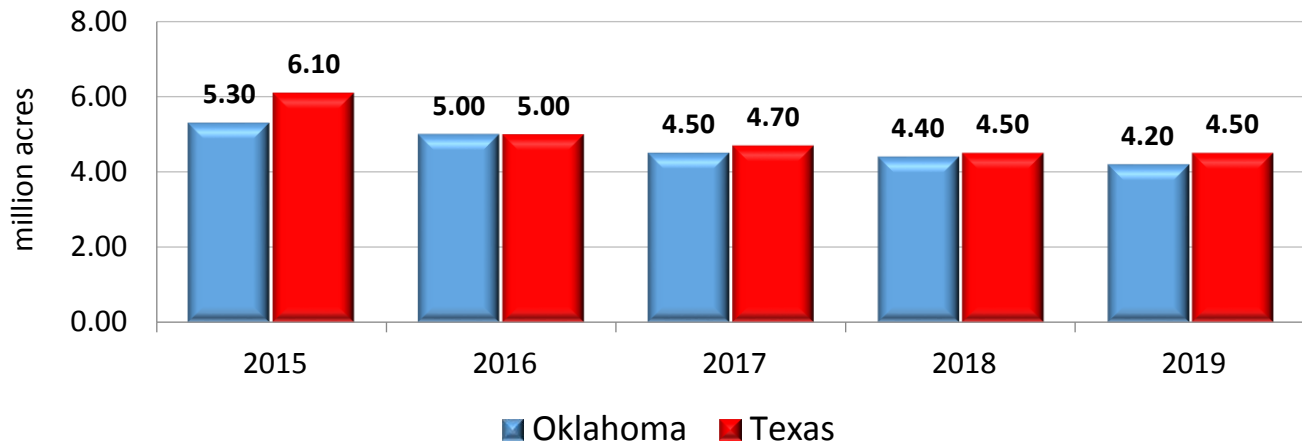

Southern Plains Wheat Seeded Acreage, 2015-2019

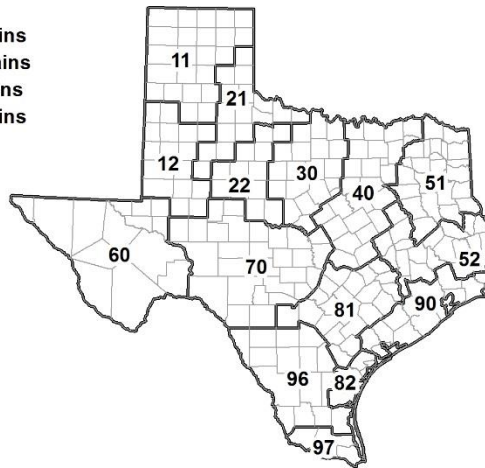
